MESSAGE FROM THE CAMP DIRECTOR

Our camp atmosphere will provide a healthy environment for learning and individual improvement. This camp is intended to give every player the skills to succeed at the high school, club, or college level. The camp curriculum will feature a combination of traditional and the most modern methods of coaching. Daily sessions will focus on various technical aspects as well as tactical and strategic playing situations. Some sessions will include full-sided matches and small-sided tournaments. Part of each session will cover plyometrics, core strength, and foot quickness drills. This camp is intended to challenge each participant to improve her soccer skills in a positive and fun environment.

CAMP DIRECTOR

Coach Ventsi Stoimirov started the women's soccer program at Grand View University in 1998. The Vikings won back-to-back Midwest Collegiate Conference titles in 2003 and 2004, and finished as runner up in 2005 and 2007. The program has been ranked regionally and nationally in the last four years and has produced numerous athletes with All-American and All-Conference recognition. Stoimirov, who has an International FIFA/UEFA "B" Coaching License, has ten years of club coaching experience. His teams have won five state championships. He was a six-year starter for the Des Moines Menace and played on teams that reached the final four of the National Tournament in 1995 and 1998. He grew up in Bulgaria, playing for the CSKA F.C. Sofia. He was a member of three national championship teams on youth and collegiate levels and the under-17 National Team Pool. Stoimirov also played in the second division of what is now the Professional Soccer League.
